

1. **Rules:** The Series and Individual championship will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - a) Each individual regatta within this series shall be governed by the rules as stated and/or modifications in each regatta's NOR and SI.
2. **Entry:** To be eligible to be scored in the **Hoosier J-24 championship** a boat must be owned by a member in good standing of either Eagle Creek Sailing Club or Indianapolis Sailing Club. A boat will be automatically entered in the **Hoosier J-24 championship** if she complies with the above requirements and competes in at least 1 of the following Regattas:
 1. **Mayors Cup Regatta (May 19-20, 2018) (ECSC)**
 2. **Geist Guzzler Regatta (June 9-10, 2018) (ISC)**
 3. **Keelboat Regatta (September 29-30, 2018) (ISC)**
 4. **Indiana Governors Cup Regatta (Sept. 15-16, 2018) (ECSC)**
3. **Fees:** There is no fee specifically for the **Hoosier J-24 championship**, however a boat must pay all fees for each individual regatta per the NOR for each regatta.
4. **Schedule:** See ECSC and ISC Club Websites for NOR and SI information for the included Regattas and Series' <http://www.ecsail.org/racing.htm> and www.indianapolissailing.org
5. **Sailing Instructions:** Will be available for each individual series or regatta according to the NOR for the individual event. <http://www.ecsail.org/racing.htm> and www.indianapolissailing.org
6. **Courses:** Courses shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions
7. **Scoring:** Each regatta shall be scored in accordance with its NOR and SI. Non ECSC and ISC boats shall be removed. If J-24s are raced in a mixed PHRF fleet, the other classes shall also be removed. Once final results of ECSC and ISC J-24s are compiled they will be assigned points based upon their finish. **The following modifies RRS 90.3 and Appendix A** - The last place boat shall receive 1 point and the second to last place boat shall receive 2 points, with each higher place receiving one additional point. The first place boat shall receive points equal to the number of boats scored in that regatta plus one. If a boat did not race in a regatta, she earns no points. **Club Championship** – The scores of the top three (3) boats from each club shall be averaged to arrive at a club score per regatta. If a club had less than three (3) boat race in a regatta the score of zero will be used in the average for boats that did not race. After all four regattas are sailed, the regatta average from each club for all four regattas shall be added together to come up with a club score. The Club that has the most points shall have their name inscribed on the traveling trophy for that year. If both clubs are tied, the club that had the most boats travel to the other club during the series shall be named the winner. If they are still tied, both club names will be inscribed.
Individual Champion – Each individual boat's scores from all four regattas will also be compiled and added together and the boat with the highest score shall be named Hoosier J-24 Champion for that year and will have their name, boat name, and Club inscribed on the traveling trophy. In the event of a tie, each boat's scores shall be listed in order from highest to lowest, and at the first point where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favor of the boat with the highest score. If they are still tied, the boat that attended the most regattas shall be named as winner. If they are still tied, the boat that beat the other boat in the last regatta shall be named the winner.
8. **Awards:** The winning club and individual boat shall have their boat name inscribed on the Hoosier J-24 Championship traveling trophy.
